All asbestos courses are in compliance with Title II of TSCA and approved under Chapter 33-15-13 of the North Dakota Air Pollution Control Rules, and by the State of Minnesota under Minnesota Rules 4620.3700.

Each state has its own requirements, so participants are encouraged to verify whether these courses meet all the necessary criteria.

Upon successful completion of an asbestos course and passing an exam, you will be eligible for state licensure.

WORKER

This 4-day course trains individuals who perform asbestos abatement work. It meets both EPA's model accreditation and state requirements for training and licensing as asbestos workers. Participants must score 70 percent or better on an exam.

PROJECT DESIGN

The sessions include abatement specifications and drawings, building systems and functional uses, preparing drawings, budgeting and cost estimation, insurance-bonding-legal considerations, and other topical areas you need to know to design abatement projects.

INSPECTOR/MANAGEMENT PLANNER

The Asbestos Inspector course is a 3-day course that includes lectures, demonstrations, and 4 hours of hands-on training.

The Asbestos Management Planner course is a 2-day training course. You must be an accredited inspector before you can be accredited as a management planner. The management planner course is required under AHERA for persons who prepare asbestos management plans for schools.
