INSPECTOR/RISK ASSESSOR

Certified inspector is an individual who has been trained by an accredited training program, and certified by EPA pursuant to §745.226 to conduct inspections. A certified inspector also samples for the presence of lead in dust and soil for the purposes of abatement clearance testing.

Certified risk assessor is an individual who has been trained by an accredited training program, and certified by EPA to conduct risk assessments. A risk assessor also samples for the presence of lead in dust and soil for the purposes of abatement clearance testing.
