## Mold Assessment Consultant

The mold assessment consultant is trained to perform all activities of a mold technician. In addition to the topics covered in the technician course, the consultant course will cover:

- Writing mold management plans and mold remediation protocols, including format and contents (structural components, HVAC systems, building contents)
- Defining affected areas
- Identifying and repairing moisture sources and their causes
- Developing a scope of work analysis
- Specifying containment and air filtration strategies
- Determining post-remediation assessment criteria and clearance standards.
