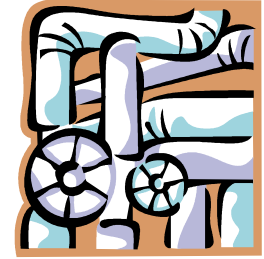

# Asbestos Operations & Maintenance

These courses will enable you to come in compliance with EPA AHERA Operations and Maintenance Requirements and also OSHA 1926.1101.

## **40 CFR Part 763.92** (AHERA)

Requires local education agencies ensure, prior to the implementation of the O&M provisions of the management plan, that: 1) all members of its maintenance and custodial staff who may work in the building which contains asbestos containing building materials (ACBM) receive awareness training of at least two hours, whether or not they are required to work with ACBM. New custodial and maintenance employees shall be trained with-in 60 days after commencement of the employment, and 2) all maintenance and custodial staff who conduct any activities that will result in the disturbance of ACBM shall receive the above 2-hour training, plus and additional 14 hours.

## **OSHA 1926.1101**

Requires employers, at no cost to the employee, institute training programs for all employees who are likely to be exposed in excess of a PEL (permissible exposure limit), and all employees who perform Class I through IV asbestos operations. Training shall be provided prior to or at the time of initial assignment and at least annually thereafter.

**Class I**—Removal of thermal system insulation (TSI) and surfacing ACM and presumed asbestos containing material (PACM.)

**Required training for class I** (Contact ETI)  
**Minimum 4 Day Worker Course**

**Class II**—Removal of materials not TSI or surfacing, including, but not limited to, asbestos containing wall board, floor tile and sheeting, roofing and siding shingles, and construction mastics.

**Required training for Class II**  
**Fee: \$200.00**  
**Minimum of 8 Hours, including hands-on.**

**Class III**—Repair and maintenance operations, where ACM, including TSI and surfacing ADM and PACM is likely to be disturbed.

**Required training for Class III**  
**Fee: \$350.00**  
**16 Hours, equivalent to AHERA O&M requirements.**

**Class IV**—Maintenance and custodial activities during which employee contact, but do not disturb, ACM and PACM, and activities to clean up dust, waste and debris resulting from Class I, II and III Activities.

**Required training for Class IV**  
**Fee: 75.00**  
**2 Hours minimum equivalent to AHERA O&M requirements.**
